Choose morning or afternoon classes or create a full-day of learning program.

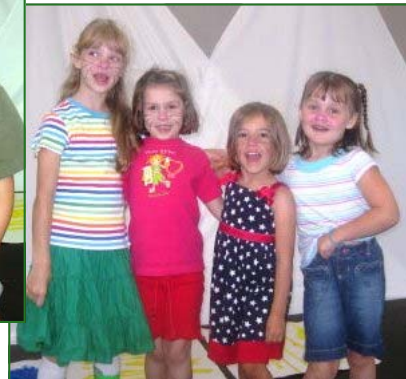
